Report on Interim Activities

Sh. Y.V. Sharma, President Welcomed the members of the Executive Committee present in the meeting. He introduced his new team of Office Bearers to the Executive Committee and sought the active cooperation and guidance of the Executive Committee in furthering the cause of Trade and Industrial Community. He informed the house that Chamber is shortly going to present a Memorandum to the Government for which he requested the members to send their valuable suggestions in writing for incorporating the same in the memorandum.

Two minutes silence was observed to mourn the sad demise of Late Sh. Ram Sahai former President and Late Sh. Narinder Gupta, former Treasurer of Chamber of Commerce & Industry.

Secretary General presented the report on the interim activities. President and his team of Office Bearers had a meeting with PGM Mobile to discuss the ban imposed on the Pre-paid mobiles in J&K. PGM was impressed upon to devise such a mechanism so that prepaid to Postpaid conversation do not cause in-conveyance to the subscribers.

The Axis Bank opened its 2nd branch in Jammu which was inaugurated by our President Shri Y.V. Sharma.

Ch. Lal Singh (M.P) visited the Chamber House on 4th November 2009 to extend his greetings to the new team of Office Bearers headed by Sh.Y.V. Sharma. The Officers of IDBI Bank also called on Sh. Y.V. Sharma President to extend their felicitations.

A delegation of Chamber of Commerce & Industry called on the Hon'ble Chief Minister and apprised him about the problems being faced by the Trade and Industry. Hon'ble Chief Minister was requested to spare some valuable time from his busy schedule to address the members of the business community to which he has agreed in principal. Chamber's Delegation led by Sh. Y.V. Sharma President called on the Dy. Chief Minister Sh. Tara Chand, Minister Incharge Housing and Urban Development and apprised him about the difficulties being faced by the but Trading community of Warehouse/Transport Nagar etc. The Dy. Chief Minister gave the patient hearing and assured that necessary steps will be taken at the earliest. Consequent upon that meeting the black topping of the main road of warehouse has been done and the other problems are also being redressed shortly.

A memorandum was submitted to the Chief Minister, Dy. Chief Minister and copies of the same have been submitted to the Political Advisor to the Chief Minister, Commissioner/ Secretary

Housing and Urban Development and Managing Director / Secretary J&K Housing Board regarding the problems of Channi Himat Housing Colony. The Chief Minister's Secretariat has forwarded the said memorandum to the commissioner / Secretary Housing and Urban Development for appropriate necessary action.

The Delegation of Chamber of Commerce & Industry had a meeting with Commissioner Commercial Taxes wherein the issues like Arbitrary enhancement of value of declared goods, seizure of documents, variation of VAT rates between our state and adjoining states, clarification of Tin numbers and problem of I.T dealers was discussed. Commissioner Commercial Taxes was requested that till the recommendations of the technical fault committee are finalized the recovery proceedings pertaining to the assessment year 2005-2006 and onwards should be put in abeyance. The Commissioner Commercial Taxes fully concurred with the points raised by the Chamber and assured that necessary instructions shall be issued to the concerned for removing the anomalies at the earliest. In a subsequent meeting with the Commissioner Commercial Taxes the case of Brick Kiln owners was also discussed.

Meeting was held with the Vice Chairman, JDA and the issues pertaining to the Regularization of Shops at Nehru Market (Block A), Matter relating to Shiv Market Railway Station, Transport Nagar, Property rights to Allottees at Warehouse, Parking facilities in Warehouse, Hike in rent of various shops, roof right to Shiv Market (Railway Station)/ Warehouse and other such markets, urgent needs for creation of more shopping Centres in the existing colonies were highlighted and discussed.

Shri Parveen Khandelwal Secretary General, Confederation of All India Traders visited Chamber House on 29th November 2009 and Ramification of Proposed Goods and Services Tax on Trade and Industry were discussed with him.

To discuss the scenario likely to emerge with the reported move of the administration to the trifurcate and shift the General Bus Stand in the name of avoiding traffic congestion in the city, a meeting of various trade organizations likely to get effected by such move was organized at Chamber House under the Chairmanship of Shri Y.V. Sharma. In the meeting it was suggested that to curb the menace of traffic congestion the General Bus Stand should be made a terminal point for boarding and un-boarding only. The idle parking of buses from the General Bus Stand should be removed. The Yards should be developed with complete infrastructure for parking and repairing of buses as is being done effectively in our neighbouring states and to develop the terrace parking over the General Bus Stand.

Sh. Y.V. Sharma, President had a meeting with Hon'ble Minister CAPD and discussed with him the order fixing the maximum stock limits of the various essential commodities by the wholesalers and retailers. Hon'ble Minister was impressed upon to strictly enhanced the stock limits to avoid storage of essential commodities.

The meeting of the price review committee under the Chairmanship of Minister CAPD was attended by Sr. Vice President Sh. Tara Chand Gupta.

Shri Y.V. Sharma, President attended the workshop organized by CII at JLN Udyog Bhawan Jammu on Goods and Service Tax(GST). He also attended another workshop on Citizen's Charter in Government Departments and assessment of Citizens feed back on the Services delivered through report Cards on department's performance. The said workshop was organized by IMPA.

Customs and Central Excise Department organized a function regarding "Launching of Automation and Central Excise and Service taxes". The said function was attended by our Sr. Vice President Sh. Tara Chand Gupta.

Meeting of the Price Sub Committee to refix the sale rate of bread was attended by the Secretary General.

Secretary General apprised the Executive Committee that instead of Rs. 13,55148 as was stated by the outgoing Secretary

General in his statement of accounts presented in General Council

Meeting on the Election day only Rs. 5,99330/- has been received by the new team and the perusal of books of accounts shows that certain payments have been made after the Receipt of report of Chartered Accountant which includes full and final payment of Rs. 6,60000/- to the Caterer on 27th of October 2009 when the catering was made on 28th October 2009.

It was observed in the meeting that it was most inappropriate on the part of out going team to clear pending bills received after the report of Chartered Accountant specially the catering bill ahead of catering day.

The Executive Committee decided to maintain status-quo for the new membership fee for enrollment of new members for the time being.

It was also decided that the old subscription of the Hon'ble Members whose voting right was stopped to deposit the arrears of subscription in three installments.
